GARY REPORT

How Satan Corrupts The Kingdom Of God

I often write to you about the ways of Yahweh. But here I want to address the ways of Satan—what he has been doing, why he does it, and what he is doing at the present. This is critical for us to understand today.

We will begin with a revealing account concerning my phone conversation with a Christian woman in England. She was inquiring about the Bride, and at one point used the familiar British word "blimey." Rightly so, I am very sensitive to words and do not use them unless I am certain what they really mean. Words are critical, as Yahshua said Himself: "But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned" (Matthew 12:36-37). Therefore, with good cause I am NOT careless with my words! So, I asked her, "What does 'blimey' mean?" She admitted she did not know. But shortly following our conversation, she called back in great surprise and said that it means "blind me"! She was also very resolute to never say that again. And if you look this up on the web, it more completely means, "God blind me!" So what one is doing in saying this is in fact asking God to blind you. And THIS is exactly what Satan wants, and he even blinds people to say and do things that not only corrupt them and deem them worthy of being judged according to Yahshua's very words and warning, but also in this blind state they defile and corrupt the Kingdom of God, the church! And this is what you will see in this Report—the corruption of the Kingdom.

To help you better understand this corruption of the Kingdom, let us look at yet another way in which one is corrupted by Satan—not just through ignorance as this lady was exercising, but by a failure to be circumspect. If Yahshua is going to condemn us by the careless use of words, then what words do people use carelessly? Let me list a few. And in this case we are specifically speaking about the actual meaning of those words.

How about someone saying "gosh" or "Oh my gosh"? What you are really saying is "God." It is using God in a careless, casual, and even meaningless way. It is disrespect for Him and defiling His title as the supreme being. And how about "shoot"? You know what it really means—it is a crude word for feces. So why say it? Would you say the true word? If not, then don't say that one either. They are one and the same. And this is the same thing with the word "crap." How about "darn" or "darn it" or "gosh darn it"? You know what you're really saying. You may even think the latter is funny. It's not. It is in fact "GD it.". And "doggone" is equally a euphemistic form of the same. Appropriate for the corrupt season, "doggone" was used three times in the Christmas classic, "It's A Wonderful Life," and one of the actors later joked about it as they knew the truth of that word at the time.

How about "Oh heck"? Would you say the same thing with the real word, "Oh hell"? If not then don't say heck either. They are one and the same. How about "frickin"? Do

you think that is better than using the real word you are saying—the crude and unacceptable word for intercourse? And this leads to the next word—"screwed" or "screwed up." And we're not talking about someone asking if one's head is screwed on right. No, "screwed" is the same thing as saying the "f" word, and there are a host of Christians who use this word, and even seek to justify it. Or how about "jeez" or "gee wiz"? Both are saying the name of Jesus without being accused of swearing. And the fact is, in all of these you are just as guilty as if you had uttered the blunt cursing or statement! In the end, there is NO difference. And there are many others like these.

And let me remind you of Yahshua's clear and straightforward warning: "But I tell you that **every** careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment. **For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned**." And in Ephesians 4:29 we read: "Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such *a word* as is good for edification according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear." And as well, most significantly words are a covenant, passing between the split covenant parts of the lips of your mouth; and speak not unclean words nor false words nor false vows, for you will be held accountable for EVERY careless word!

Now, having noted this, do you recall why we set forth all of it? It was to reveal how Satan corrupts the Kingdom of Heaven, the church. And it's real simple. "That which has been is that which will be, and that which has been done is that which will be done. So there is nothing new under the sun" (Ecclesiastes 1:9). The way Satan corrupts words, and thereby causes men to sin, is the way he corrupts the church and causes it to sin

To start with, the church was the kingdom given to man too early, or before the time. Therefore, it was destined to fail in the last two thousand years. This is what we saw in the previous "Gary Report" titled "The True Reformation." That corruption began as early as when they cast lots for a replacement for Judas, the twelfth apostle. They were soon disbursed, and then came the Saul/Paul period of the church, the Body of Christ. This work was clearly evidenced by the three thousand who were killed in Exodus 32 on Pentecost at Mount Sinai. These clearly represent the three thousand years of Christianity. God was not pleased with them, and neither has He been pleased with the two thousand years of Christianity, and it would be the same for another thousand years if they continued. The church has been a corrupt work all this time, but man acts like it is OK. And that is where we see the same thing with these words that are corrupt and unclean, where to remedy this for their continued usage they have to modify them slightly to make them more acceptable. Such is the church.

Without a doubt the church is unclean, even as are these words, especially so today. They are worldly in their music and even in their messages. They take the world's music that is popular and simply change the words. This is PRECISELY what we see with these unclean, vulgar, worldly words and phrases. In the same manner, the church takes the unclean things of the world, alters them slightly, make the lingo God, and feed this dung to Christians. They are motivational speakers, and not preachers of righteousness. They run a business, and it has to appeal to the masses or the people will leave.

And, they let the people dress and look like the world, committing harlotry with the world. So here again, as with the words and phrases mentioned above, all the church does is accept the vulgar and unclean into the church, and change the dress oh so slightly so that in comparison they don't look as bad or corrupt. This includes the women's makeup and immodesty. Again, Satan alters things slightly so that it is not as offensive, but he knows it is the identical guilt and sin. Again, he makes them think it is now ok since it is slightly altered and now acceptable to the masses. "Darn it!"

And how about the word of God when it comes to righteousness? To corrupt them Satan deceives them with a false message of "grace." He tells the people that we are no longer under "law" but under grace, and makes that "grace" so pervasive that there is no longer any accountability for sin. Thus, people have no aversion to sin, and instead think it is a free ride to heaven. So there is no longer a concern for worldly sinful behavior.

Furthermore, with the sin of feminism rampant throughout the earth, so that the church is not stiff and out of sync with society, they are now letting women become preachers and pastors and church leaders and teachers, and they too falsely justify it. Just like these subject words and phrases that are sinful and offensive and wrong, the church will not call it for what it is and make this corruption sound more acceptable. Even so, the practice is still wrong, as are those altered words.

And again, this is the work of Satan. The Catholics did the same thing with indulgences. They put it in acceptable religious language so that it did not sound so bad, until the Reformation when people spoke the truth concerning them. And this is precisely what is needed today—the true Reformation that is the preacher of righteousness and the obedient people: "The rod shall not depart from Judah, nor the decree from between his feet, until to whom it belongs comes, **obedient people**" (Genesis 49:10).

Again, all Christianity is today is taking the unclean and unacceptable and change the lingo a little bit so as to disguise the wrong and "market" it as acceptable. But in truth it is just the repackaging of the corrupt! Satan does this to make men fools and thereby corrupt the kingdom. They become like the world, and the Scriptures aptly warn: "You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God" (James 4:4). And if Satan can accomplish this, he knows God will judge them. And this is why He must cut time short, form a bride, take her up to heaven, transform her into the heavenly, and return and rule on this earth, binding Satan and setting up His kingdom on this corrupt world.

And let us close with this most important and revealing testimony/message. In the closing verses of first Remnant Matthew 26, we read of Peter's denial of Yahshua three times. Then in verse 74 we find a most relevant statement: "Then he [Peter] began to curse and swear, 'I do not know the man!' And immediately a rooster crowed." And in Christianity Mark 14:71 we read the like account: "But he [Peter] began to curse and swear, 'I do not know this man you are talking about!'" Finally, in the second Remnant Luke 22:60 like account, as well as the Kingdom John 18:27 like account, there was no cursing or swearing.

In Revelation 19:7-8 we read: "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready.' It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints." Brothers and sisters, if the Bride is to make herself ready and clothe herself in the righteous acts of the saints, one of the critical things she will do is to clean up her mouth and let no unwholesome word proceed from it. And this is true not only with her mouth, but with her eyes as well—what we look at—and with her ears—what we listen to. Whether it be the eye port, the ear port, or the mouth port, we must be circumspect.

So if there is no cursing or swearing in Second Remnant Luke, and certainly not in Kingdom John, then from henceforth there should be no uncleanness in ANY Bride members mouth, period. And let me remind you, we don't catch ourselves up to heaven at the sound of the trumpet, but rather we are caught up apart from any of our abilities. So let us live our lives circumspectly, and prove ourselves worthy of His calling—and not just in this one area of what comes out of our mouths, but in every area of our lives.

May we glorify the Father in all we say or do.
